The major objective of this project is to ensure sustainable, eco-friendly, biodegradable and safe alternative to synthetic sanitary napkins. The purpose behind this project is to not only promote eco-friendly alternatives but also inculcate entrepreneurship and employability skills among women students of Guru Nanak College. The beneficiaries will initially be women students and staff of Guru Nanak College. In future, the benefit will be extended to general public too.

The Sanitary napkin was tested (as per Indian Standards IS 5405/1980) at Technical & Innovative Textile Solution Center, an ISO 9001 certified Testing Lab. The report concluded that herbal sanitary napkin is organic & Bio-degradable and meets all requirements and passes the test. The faculty and Students have completed the Sanitary making Certificate course and are trained to produce the product.
